Camp Taconic Covid Plan

***TO SHOW PROOF OF VACCINATION, GO TO OUR GOOGLE CLASSROOM TO THE "VACCINATION CARDS" ASSIGNMENT, CLICK IT, UPLOAD YOUR CARD, AND CLICK "TURNED IN."**

- All students whether vaccinated or not, will get tested for Covid 3 days prior to going away to camp.
- All students whether vaccinated or not, will get tested again on first day (at camp).
- All students whether vaccinated or not, will get tested on day 5 (or day before going back on bus).
- All buses will be completely sanitized before boarding and each child will get a squirt of hand sanitizer from a chaperone. Masks must be worn at all times.
- All parent chaperones whether vaccinated or not, will be tested prior to going away to camp. Parents must provide a negative covid test even if they've been fully vaccinated.
- All students regardless of vaccination status must wear their mask on the bus to and from camp.
- We can effectively space out indoors and outdoors with all proper PPE. As an extra layer of safety, we will purchase bell covers which acts as a mask on all woodwinds and brass instruments.
- All band members will be wearing masks, even those that play woodwinds and brass instruments. We will purchase a special kind of filtered mask that always woodwinds and brass to play.
- All students will have their own water bottles labeled with their name.
- Have only a maximum of students per cabin to ensure that each student is spaced out with ample room (6-12ft apart). We will utilize more cabins to make this happen.
- All meals will have both an indoor and outdoor seating option so less people are eating in the same location. Each section will be spaced out properly at 6ft per student.
- Enforce cleaning of cabins with disinfectant daily.
- Enforce cleaning of all instruments and equipment daily.
- No students in anyone else's cabin but their own.
- No sharing of instruments or equipment.
- Teach and reinforce hand-washing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and increase monitoring to ensure adherence among students and staff.
- If soap and water are not readily available, hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol will be utilized.
- Broadcast regular announcements on reducing the spread of COVID-19 on PA system at each meal.
- Keep each students' belongings separated from others' and in individually labeled containers, cubbies, or areas.
- The nurse, staff, and parents will conduct daily health checks (temp checks) at the start of each day.
- Immediately separate staff and campers with COVID symptoms.
- We will have a large quarantine cabin to separate anyone who has COVID symptoms.
- For all students that cannot attend camp for COVID related issues, you will still be allowed to participate in the program! Please contact Mr. Mauriello for further details.
